## WHO NEEDS TO QUARANTINE?

People who have been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19—excluding people who have had COVID-19 within the past 3 months or who are fully vaccinated.

---

### What Counts as close Contact?

You were within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more

You provided care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19

You had direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them)

You shared eating or drinking utensils  
They sneezed, coughed, or somehow got respiratory droplets on you

### After Contact, then what...?

Stay home for 10 days after your last contact with a person who has COVID-19.

Watch for fever (100.4°F), cough, shortness of breath, or other symptoms of COVID-19

Keep your distance from others, especially people who are at higher risk for getting very sick from COVID-19

**IF YOU HAVE A FEVER, COUGH OR DIFFICULTY BREATHING, SEEK CARE AND ASK TO BE TESTED. FOLLOW MEDICAL ADVICE.**
